MANDATORY ADMINISTRATION CRITERIA

Submissions that do not meet the following criteria will not be evaluated and will be disqualified:

Bidders must accept the ACSA terms and conditions.

Bidders must produce a valid letter of good standing issued by the Department of Labour.

If bidders are on a joint venture, then a valid JV certificate signed by both parties will be required.

Bidders must produce a valid SARS tax clearance certificate.

Bidders must provide an active & valid CIDB registration with 3 SF grading, bidders with a grading CIDB 2 SF PE maybe accepted
Bidders need to be registered with the Central Supplier Database (CSD).

Bidding entities (companies to provide SANS 1475 permit) the technical staff must demonstrate active and valid registration with the South African Qualification & Certification Committee for the Fire Industry (SAQCC)

Attend the compulsory site briefing

NB: No tender will be awarded to any person whose tax matters have not been declared to be in order by the

South African Revenue Services. EVALUATION

Mandatory Administration Requirements

Bidders must satisfy the Mandatory Administration Criteria in order for them to be evaluated further. Proposals will then be evaluated in 2 Phases:

Phase One - Functionality

Functionality: Is a threshold phase which will disqualify bidder's not meeting the minimum threshold per element as indicated in the Bid Document.

Phase Two - Price & B-BEET

This phase is based on the 80/20 Preference point system in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, with 80 points reflecting price and 20 reflecting B-BEET recognition. ACSA will only accept the DTI criteria as proof of B-BEET status.

TRANSFORMATION IMPERATIVES

Airports Company South Africa subscribes to the National Transformation Imperatives and objectives. As such it will appoint bidder(s) who subscribe to Transformation imperatives. Bidders must indicate whether they commit to the ACSA transformation strategy.
