MANDATORY CRITERIA

Tenderers that do not meet any one of the following minimum criteria will be disqualified and will not be evaluated further:

- 1] Bidders must attend a compulsory site briefing session (Form A1)
- 2] Bidders/Lead Bidders in a JV must have a minimum **CIDB grading of 2ME** or higher (Form B2)
- 3] Bidders must be on National Treasury's CSD (Form A10)
- 4] Bidders should complete and sign Standard Bid Documents (SBD Forms A5 – A7); and

PRE-QUALIFICATION

Only bidders who meet the following criteria will be will qualify to be evaluated:

To be recognized as responsive the tenderer

- Must be B-BBEE level of 1, 2, 3 or 4. Copy of a valid B-BBEE certificated shall be submitted as a returnable document with this tender (Form C3), or,
- Tenderers that do not meet the above shall allocate **20% of the contract value** towards the advancement of QSE's or EME's as stipulated in the Tender Document.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail tenders will not be

accepted.

EVALUATION

Bids will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 Preference point system as per the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Regulations 2017.
