### EVALUATION

#### Mandatory Administration Requirements

Bidders must satisfy the Mandatory Administration Criteria in order for them to be evaluated further. Proposals will then be evaluated in 2 Phases:

#### Phase One - Functionality

Functionality: Is a threshold phase which will disqualify bidder's not meeting the minimum threshold per element as indicated in the Bid Document.

### Phase Two - Price & B-BEEE

This phase is based on the 80/20 Preference point system in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, with 80 points reflecting price and 20 reflecting B-BBEE recognition. ACSA will only accept the DTI criteria as proof of B-BBEE status.

### TRANSFORMATION IMPERATIVES

Airports Company South Africa subscribes to the National Transformation Imperatives and objectives. As such it will appoint bidder(s) who subscribe to Transformation imperatives. Bidders must indicate whether they commit to the ACSA transformation strategy.
