2.1 Background and/or Purpose of this Bid

Chief Dawid Stuurman International Airport is Airports Company South Africa's largest regional airport which handled just under 1,2 million passengers in 2023. Chief Dawid Stuurman International Airport site measures approximately 420 hectares and comprises 2 paved active runways, with a cross-system runway configuration. The passenger terminal area is located on the northern side of the main runway, with the general aviation area and the cargo area lying to the west of the terminal area.

ACSA's Strategy is centred around three core pillars: Run Airports, Develop Airports and Grow Footprint. These pillars define ACSA's reason for being as an organisation and give expression to our key areas of strategic focus.

The most relevant strategic pillar for this project is Develop Airports. The Company aims to develop airports in line with strategic land use plans in order to:

- Create value to our shareholders.
- Develop and maintain world class airports (all development must entrench this identity).
- Support increased traffic through the provision of new capacity and facilities when required.
- Reduce environmental impact.

The decision to expand the existing Terminal at Chief Dawid Sturman International Airport was based on the following primary objectives:

- To provide additional terminal capacity to adequately address future demand.
- To provide adequate commercial facilities such as retail, food and beverage facilities.
- To improve the overall passenger level of service and provide related passenger amenities.
- Ensure flexibility in development and operations to meet changing demands over the time.
- Enhance the segregation of international and domestic passengers.
- To integrate the new build terminal areas with the old, creating one seamless airport experience.

2.2 Scope of Work

The upgrading of the existing terminal from approximately 1,7 MAP capacity to a capacity of 3.5 MAP with fit out only commensurate of the requirement for 2,5MAP. The scope of work is to produce a design for the Terminal Expansion and associated works at Chief Dawid Sturman International Airport, in accordance with a functional layout concept developed by Airports Company South Africa (ACSA).

The scope will comprise of:

- A wrap-around concept on the existing terminal by adding a 10m module to the landside, two 10m modules to the east, and four 10m modules on the west side.
- The existing airside waiting / holding lounge is extended by 5 meters (½ module) to airside, adding 50% to the floor area of the holding lounges.
- The spine is the landside concourse, creating improved access to terminal processors and to commercial and retail facilities for all passengers.

Other facilities in the scope will include but not limited to:

- IT server rooms & switch rooms
- Passenger self-service elements (bag drop, SSK, e-gates)
- Telecom, PABX & PA server rooms
- FIDS
- IT Backbone for tenants
- Office components related to ACSA operations.
- Common use restrooms, training facility and boardrooms
- Ablution facilities
- Storage Areas
- Delivery Areas
- Plant rooms (inclusive of Air conditioning and HVAC fixed installations)
- Goods screening point

Other design considerations

- All terminal elements should be designed and placed in the spatial grid with the aim of providing clear passenger flows and orientation. Following the concept layouts, the terminal has to be designed around the primary aviation flows. All ancillary functions should be placed such that it does not impede on the primary processes but supports it.
- The design the terminal should aim to minimize capital expenditure required to realize operational objectives but simultaneously address the aspect of minimum maintenance and operational costs attached to it during the life cycle. The professional team is expected to be innovative to achieve this objective.

A model is to be developed by the professional team to clearly indicate the optimum combination of structure and finishes required to achieve a world class facility and simultaneously restrict upfront capital and ongoing operational expenditure to a minimum.

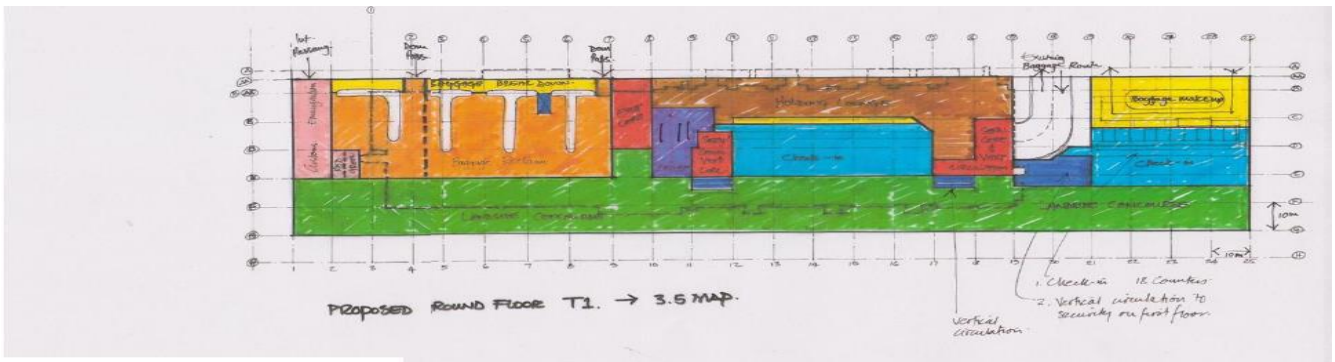

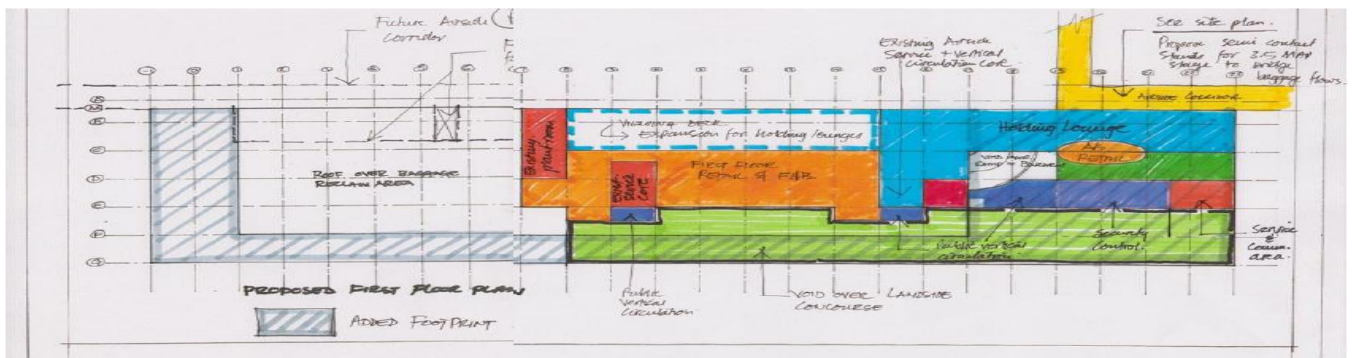
