Cape Town International Airport, East London Airport, Port Elizabeth International Airport and Kimberley Airport are subject to renaming, which forms part of the Transformation of Heritage Landscape government programme.

The proposed renaming will be implemented in terms of the South African Geographical Names Council Act of 1998 (Act No. 118 of 1998) and, therefore, the South African public is requested to forward their proposals and comments to Airports Company South Africa before **6 June 2018**.
