Objections must be addressed to NERSA for the attention of the Executive Manager: Petroleum Pipelines Regulation, and must be:

Members of the public and stakeholders are requested to indicate to NERSA, through the addresses mentioned above, if they wish to present their views orally at a hearing. Please note that NERSA will not schedule and/or hold a hearing if no party has indicated that they are interested in making oral representation to the Energy Regulator concerning the matters published in this notice by the closing date for objections mentioned below.

All objections must be lodged by close of business on **30 July 2026**. Objections received after this date will be disregarded.
