FLYING HIGH WITH CARBON ACCREDITATION RATINGS

The drive to reduce our carbon footprint has advanced with updates by Airports Council International to the Airport Carbon Accreditation status of five airports.

O. R. Tambo International Airport and Cape Town International Airport have been upgraded to Level 2 (Reduction) status.

King Shaka International Airport and Port Elizabeth International Airport have been renewed at Level 1 (Mapping).

George Airport has entered the carbon accreditation programme with a grading of Level1 (Mapping).
