NB. Bidders to allow time for COVID protocol, late submissions will be not accepted.

The Tender will be Evaluated in 3 Phases as follows:

1. MANDATORY ADMIN REQUIREMENTS

- Acceptance of terms and conditions of bid
- Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) letter of support confirming the bidder is an approved OEM Dealer/agent for the supply, distribution

including spare parts and maintenance support in South Africa.

- 30 percent (30%) locally manufactured (made up of 100% for Assembly, Crew Cabin and Superstructure) or have directives from DTI -bidders to submit completed SBD6,2 form and SATS1286 form.

2. TECHNICAL EVALUATION

The evaluation process will be based on threshold criteria. Bidders must meet the minimum threshold points per criterion of Functionality before proceeding to the next phase of Evaluations. Bidders which fail to achieve the minimum threshold of 70 will not be considered further in the evaluation.

3. PRICE AND BBBEE

This is the final stage of the evaluation process and will be based on the PPPFA preference point system of 90/10. Price will amount to 90 points, whilst preference will be 10 points.
